CLASS NEWS

Kynance Class—

The children have settled well after the Christmas break. I have enjoyed meeting them, and getting to know them. I will be holding a parent chat on Wednesday (10th January) at 3.30pm, in Kynance class. I look forward to meeting you then.

Next week we will look at New Year's resolutions- what we are good at and what we would like to get better at. We will look at number- comparing amounts by counting them and ordering them.

Gwithian Class—

A huge welcome back! I hope you had a wonderful well-rested, much-needed break. It has been great to see the children again and we are excited to start spring term. Next week we will be reciting our new story - Whatever Next. We will be looking at using conjunctions to extend our writing. In Maths, we are continuing to look at subtraction and fact families. In Science, we are going to discover what we know about weather systems already and in Topic, we are beginning our research on Neil Armstrong

Sennen Class—

Next week in Sennen Class we are going to be having a Non-Fiction week on Instruction Writing. We will learn how to make a jam sandwich and then innovate these instructions to make our own sandwiches (which we will make on Friday - yum!) In Maths next week we are having a week on Time. In Science we will be investigating whether bricks are absorbent or not and in Topic we will be thinking about what we want to find out about The Great Fire of London. We also have a class trip to Truro Fire Station to find out more about fire engines and the modern day fire service.

Fistral Class—

In Fistral next week we will be continuing to analysing and create humorous poems in Literacy. During maths, we will be focussing on fractions. In science, we will be investigating how magnets are used. During topic we will be investigating Viking beliefs.

Pentire Class—

This term Pentire will be covering the topic on coasts. Within Literacy, we will be learning the story by Michael Morpurgo titled 'the wreck of the Zanzibar.' In numeracy we will be starting our learning focus on using addition and subtraction to problem solve. In Topic work, we will be starting our unit on coasts and we will be exploring about the varied coastlines in the U.K. In science we will be finding out about states of matter with a focus on gases next week. P.E will be on Fridays this term. Please remember your P.E kit

Marazion Class—

In English next week, Marazion will begin to identify and discuss the features of short narratives. They will focus on developing a character and setting using descriptive language. During maths next week, Marazion will add and subtract fractions with different denominations and mixed numbers. In science, we will be investigating light. The children will explain that light travels in straight lines and how we are able to see.
