Welcome back to the summer term. We will be carrying out a science investigation tomorrow and your child will need to bring an empty plastic bottle, with its lid, to class, in the morning. This will be used to make a pulley system.

Please continue to hear your child **read daily** and sign their home reading record to show you have done this. You will also find their new spellings and tables stapled into their book for this week. These are your copy to keep at home. The test will be on Friday. Results will be shared in the comments section.

Please continue to use their reading record as a communication tool and let us know if there are any updates or new information, we need to be made aware of.

The topics this term will be 'Sow, Grow and Farm', 'Cornwall's Mining Heritage' and 'Fallen Fields'. In English we will be writing instructions, explanations and discussion texts before half term and poetry, narrative and biography after half term. We will be reading 'Tom's Midnight Garden' for our first text when we have finished 'Secrets of a Sun King'. In maths, we will continue to learn about fractions, go onto learn about geometry and finish up with measures including 'time'. It would be really good if your child could start wearing an analogue watch, with numbers clearly marked on it, as we will be referring regularly to the time during the day.

As it is the summer term, your child will need to start wearing sun cream, a hat for outdoor play and they need to bring a bottle, **labelled with their name**, to top up with fresh water, throughout the day. Having their own drinks bottle is vital in order to keep them hydrated. We have two snack breaks during the morning, and it would be great to see your child bringing fruit to eat at these times.
