Year 2 SATs - Year 2 will be taking formal SATs assessments over the course of the next two weeks from Monday 16th May.

They make up part of the evidence that teachers use to make their Teacher Assessment judgement. These SATs will be kept low key for the children. They will be part of normal class-room activities and we try to avoid the word 'test' when discussing them with your children.

All teachers endeavour to make this a stress-free time and we ask that you support us with this. You do not need to complete any additional test practice at home but **please ensure children come to school every day on time, well rested and with full tummies!** 

EYFS Reading meeting - There will be a meeting for all Reception parents on <u>Wednesday 18th</u> <u>May at 8:45am</u>. This will be a chance to understand how we teach phonics in school and give you the best advice for how to support your child at home with their learning. And of course to ask any questions you may have regarding phonics and reading. Miss Laing will escort you to the meeting after you drop off your child on that morning. 3 part apology - We have been reviewing our current behaviour policy and, after observing children's behaviour across the school, we have created a new approach to use when dealing with behaviour in and out of the classroom. This is called 'The 3 Part Apology' We were hoping that as parents and carers you may consider adopting a similar approach at home when situations arise, such as fall outs between siblings etc. As a school we believe that it is never too late to turn a situation around and we will always allow the child the chance to do that.


