This Topic is called Off With Her Head. We will be exploring a range of subjects through this topic with a real focus on history.

### Art

Creating portraits of Henry VIII.

- We will be developing our sketches using line drawings.
- We will be finishing them by highlighting the necessary lines in pen, removing the sketched lines and adding colour.

### Science: Electricity (Covid Catch Up)

- Identify common appliances that run on electricity.
- Construct a simple series electrical circuit, identifying and naming basic parts.
- Recognise that a switch opens and closes a circuit and associate that with whether or not a lamp lights up.
- Recognise some common conductors and insulators, associating metals with being good conductors.

### Maths

We will be extending our knowledge of calculating with money, learning about negative numbers and improving our ability to multiply and divide with larger numbers.

### Computing

We will continue to improve our ability to create E-Books using Book Creator and will extend our skills by learning how to insert and edit pictures..

### Literacy

- We will learn how to write newspaper reports to report on a chosen event.
- We will be writing persuasive letter to Henry VIII to persuade him to change the crimes and punishments of the time.

### History

We will be studying the Tudor period with a particular focus on the crime and punishment of the time. We will also be learning about Henry VIII's six marriages and his role in the reformation of the church.

### RE

We will be exploring what it means to be a Muslim in Britain today. We will be learning about how following this religion is different to Christianity and how some of the 5 pillars of Islam are followed in modern Britain.

### PSHE

We will be learning about what it means to celebrate various types of difference through the Jigsaw topic – Celebrating Difference.
